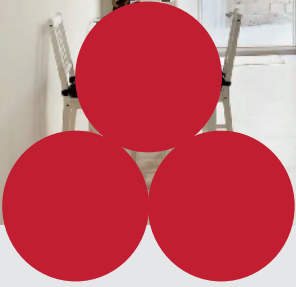

WHAT TO SEE IN BARI

- 1 BASILICA SAN NICOLA**

The Basilica of San Nicola has a beautifully decorated gilded wooden ceiling dating back to the 17th century. The church is often pervaded by the scent of incense and the sound of the prayers of pilgrims arriving from the most disparate places.
- 2 CATHEDRAL SAN SABINO**

The other important church in the Old Town hides a late Baroque crypt built on the ancient Roman foundations and a small medieval church.
- 3 CASTLE NORMANNO SVEVO**

The Byzantine heritage of Bari is evident instead by looking at the towers and moat of the 12th-century Norman-Swabian Castle, which often hosts artistic and cultural exhibitions.
- 4 THEATER MARGHERITA**

The Teatro Margherita near the port, originally inaugurated in 1914, is one of the most loved and recognized buildings in Bari

COSA MANGIARE A BARI

- FOCACCIA AND BREAD**

Greasy hands, ecstatic palate, full belly. Focaccia in Bari is not just street food, but a mystical-religious experience that fully involves all the senses. The focaccia, made with potatoes or covered with cherry tomatoes, satisfies all palates, from a simple snack to a complete meal.
- ORECCHIETTE**

The name of the Bari pasta par excellence is suggested by their shape that recalls, in fact, small ears. The people of Bari also call them strascenate to recall the preparation: with a knife, small pieces of pasta are dragged onto a table.
- PANZEROTTO**

The fried panzerotto is a convivial ritual that accompanies the Bari in all seasons. In the local tradition, their preparation involves entire families, gathered around a table whitened with flour, ready to be stuffed. In Bari the most common variants include meat or turnips.
